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Abstract: Goody considers the Eurocentric shortcomings of western historiography and offers correctives that comprehend institutional and cultural commonalities across Bronze Age Eurasia and eschew upstreaming from the rise of Europe.

I am looking at an equal-area map of the world; that is, a map that shows land areas in their correct proportions to each other, even if some shapes become distorted.¹ It is a plain white outline map uncluttered by features that might influence perception (Espenshade 1990:43). There is Europe: a little tail of land, even if we include the mass of Russia, trailing west from the great Eurasian continent. In Barry Cunliffe's words, Europe is "The westerly excrescence of...Asia" (2008:vii).

I bring up Cunliffe because of what he writes a few sentences later: "What made Europe so influential was the restlessness of its people: it was almost as if they were hard-wired to be mobile" (vii). I will speak plainly. Balderdash. That statement, from an archaeologist who should know better, exemplifies a whole genre of large-scale historical writing that places Europe at the center of world history and tries to explain the rise of European dominance from the sixteenth through the twentieth centuries as a consequence of special or inherent European attributes. These include restlessness, racial excellence, superior imagination, superior rationality, climate and environment, bays and harbors,
